10/08/01 Apologies. Cllrs Mrs D Croney, Mrs J Major, R Smith T Payne, A Campbell (DCC).

10/08/02 Declarations of interest. Cllr Jones declared a personal interest in planning application 2010/0719 and Tree works at 6 The Paddocks.

10/08/03 Minutes of the last meeting. It was proposed by Cllr Benfield, seconded by Cllr Jones that the minutes of the meeting held on 5th July 2010 be accepted. They were signed by the Chairman. **Nem Con.**

10/08/04 Matters arising from the minutes:

10/08/05 Report from County Councillor. None available

10/08/06 Report from District Councillor. Email report was read out. Attached to minutes

10/08/07 Development control matters listed on the schedule:

a.	2009/0688 &0689 - The Chantry – Appeal ongoing
b.	2010/0640 Brook Bungalow, The Chalk. It was proposed by Cllr Jones, seconded by Cllr Benfield that an objection be raised on the use of cedar cladding. Nem Con
c.	2010/0719 - 7 The Paddocks. Following discussion including comments from absent councillors, it was agreed that an objection be raised on the size first floor extension, wall cladding and the requirement for an additional garage.
d.	Tree works - 6 The Paddocks. Following discussion, it was agreed that no objection be raised.

10/08/08 Grant aid to the Iwerne Minster Summer Sports. An email from Mrs Emma Lewis was read to members. Concern was expressed that no accounts had been published to last year's event and was this to be an annual request for support. The Clerk was request to find out more detail.

10/08/09 Pay bills listed on the schedule. It was proposed by Cllr Benfield, seconded by Cllr Jones that the bills on the schedule be paid. **Nem Con**

10/08/10 Article 4 direction in respect of UPVC windows. Mr Nadin outlined the requirement stemming from the public consultation on the Village Design Statement (VDS). **It was proposed by Cllr Jones, Seconded by Cllr Hooper that a request for an Article 4 direction should be made to NDDC.**

10/08/11 The official naming of Post Office Lane. The Clerk highlighted that Post Office Lane is not named on certain digital mapping systems. Mr Beck informed the members that a resolution had been agreed in his time as Clerk that it should be called Post Office Road. There was no requirement for any signage. The Clerk undertook to pursue the matter with the appropriate authority (Afternote: Licensing at NDDC will assist)

10/08/12 Other parish matters:

- a. Highways.** The A350 closure notice will be issued shortly for the work at Barbers Cottage. It is expected to take place in November. The new signs at Tower Hill were welcomed.
- b. Recreation.** It was agreed that the old goalposts should be removed from behind the sheds. Concern was expressed at the amount of rubbish between the club and the sheds. The village club expressed their appreciation for the effort to move the goalposts (which will be done in September after the sports)
- c. Rights of way.** There was discussion about the issues with FP24 where the path has had a fence put across it at the northern end; DCC to be asked to visit.
- d. Vital Villages.** Nothing to report.
- e. Village Design Statement (VDS).** Mr Nadin reported that work to complete the revised layout of the VDS was progressing well. Additional mapping has been inserted by North Dorset who wish to use the VDS as a model template for other councils.
- f. Community Planning.** The DT11 Partnership has been involved in a Western Gazette article on the public perception of the 2012 Olympics within Dorset.
- g. Abingdon Hall Project.** Nothing to report

10/08/13 Iwerne Minster HomeWatch. Nothing to report. HomeWatch reports have been circulated.

10/08/14 DAPTC matters. The Clerk highlighted issues from recent DAPTC circulars including the law on parish council tax capping.

10/08/15 Matters arising from recent correspondence. The Clerk summarised the correspondence listed on the schedule.
